The easiest way to do this is:

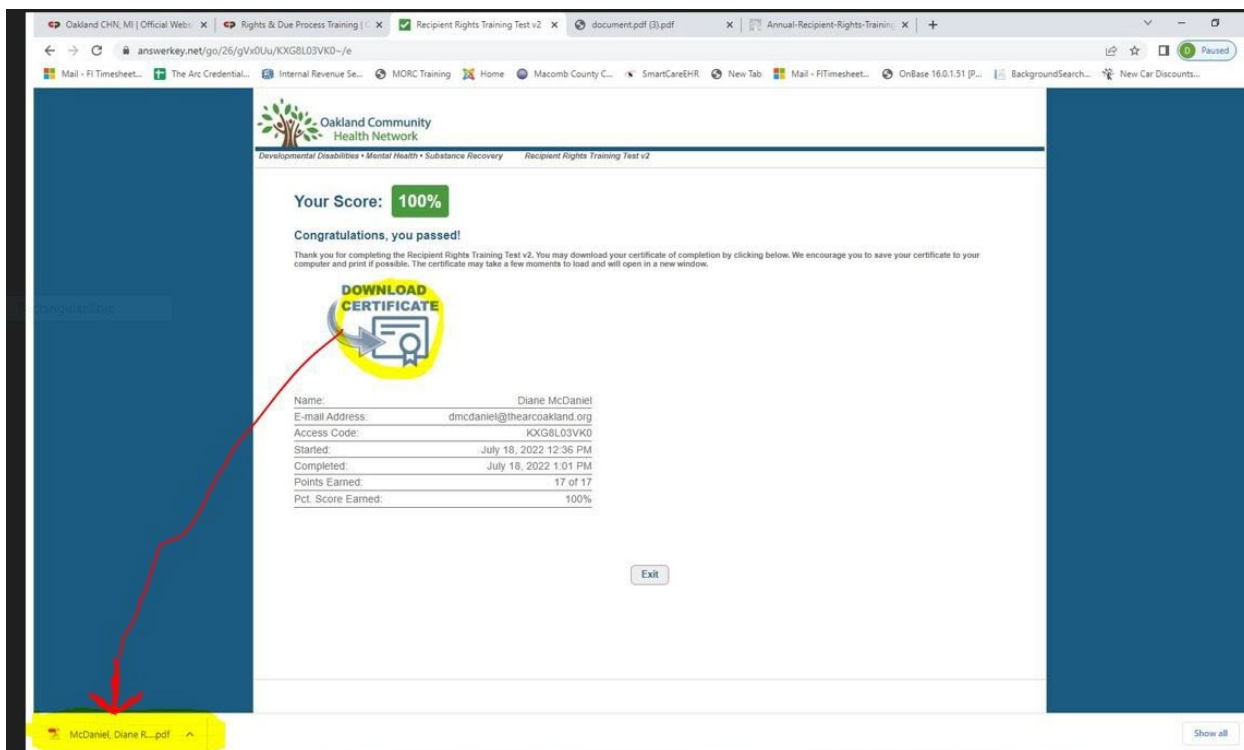
You can right click on [Recipients Rights Training Presentation \(PDF\)](#) & it takes you right to the link to the Presentation and then the test.

You must complete the training prior to taking the test. The test link is available at the end of the presentation. Answers to registration questions: **(Employer/Agency is ARC, Core provider is MORC, Hire Date is your start date.)** Print out the certificate on completion of the test. (certificate pops up as a pdf in the lower corner of the screen.) Or if you cannot print, take a screen shot, pic with your phone and email to Arc, or save as a pdf and email to Arc. See attachment.

And once the page is up, type in Bloodborne Pathogens on the page search. It should bring up the free course. You will have to make an account on the Michigan Virtual Professional Learning Portal website to proceed. When I registered, I had to create an account: **email, name, cell #, other, I don't have a PIC, make a password, (write it down), County-Oakland, District-other.** Watch for emails for other emails sent for the portal & log in info.

Mae sure to get a certificate and send to the Arc.

If you are expired, you cannot provide Medicaid paid services to your client until completed.
